Carroll Electric Children of Members Scholarship Competition

Purpose:

The purpose of our scholarship competition is to encourage our young people to further their education. The scholarship monies to be awarded are as follows:

<u>Boys</u>	<u>Girls</u>
1 st Place - \$1,200	1 st Place - \$1,200
2 nd Place - \$800	2 nd Place - \$800
3 rd Place - \$400	3 rd Place - \$400

Rules and Regulations:

To be eligible for the Carroll Electric Scholarship Awards, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applications:

1. Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for college or proper* vocational or technical school entrance. *Proper vocational or technical school means one beyond high school where credits can be transferred to a state accredited four-year college.
2. Applicants must be a son, daughter, or legal ward of a Carroll Electric Cooperative, Inc. member and receiving service at the time of competition.
3. Applicants in both divisions must have a current career average of "B" or better (3.5 pt. on 4 pt. system) and be accepted and then enrolled when they receive the award in an accredited college or proper vocational/technical school of student's choice. Applicants, who are accepted and then enrolled in an accredited school of nursing, working toward a degree, are also eligible.
4. Members of the immediate families and persons residing in the households of trustees, managers, distribution cooperative employees of Carroll Electric are not eligible to participate in this competition.
5. Applications for the Carroll Electric competition must be submitted on the application forms provided by Carroll Electric or downloaded from <http://www.cecpower.coop>. The application forms must be returned to the co-op office by February 1 of the current year.
6. Applications must be typed and information must be confined to the official nomination form with no attachments other than grade transcripts. (Teacher recommendations must be no more than one paragraph.)
7. Any applicant who has received a full scholarship (tuition, room, board and books) to the school of his/her choice is not eligible for a scholarship from Carroll Electric.
8. All scholarships must be accepted in the first academic year after proof of enrollment is received by Carroll Electric. However, an extension of one year may be granted for just cause in the judgment of the CEO of Carroll Electric. In the event a student is unable to fulfill his enrollment obligation under this program, the award is forfeited.
9. Personal interviews will be conducted with qualifying applicants. The applicants will receive points for scholastic record, personal achievement, school and community activities. Points will also be awarded for poise, personality and appearance in the interview.
10. Winners will be notified as soon as possible after judging. *One boy and one girl from each division will be chosen to represent Carroll Electric in the statewide scholarship competition where they will compete for additional monies. Eligibility requirements apply.*
