General Rules & Guidelines for the Youth Tour Applicant

The applicant must be a sophomore or junior in high school. The student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be members of Carroll Electric Cooperative, Inc. residing in a home receiving electric service from Carroll Electric at the time of competition. Carroll Electric Cooperative, Inc. will sponsor one student to participate in the annual Washington, D.C. Youth Tour Program.

Youth Tour testing and interviews will be conducted each spring and will take place at the cooperative office located at 350 Canton Road, N.W., Carrollton, OH 44615. Applicants will be contacted with their interview date and time once all applications have been received.
