Apprentice Lineman

Carroll Electric Cooperative, Inc. is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Apprentice Lineman.

The successful candidate will be required to complete an apprenticeship program consisting of on-the-job training and training at a recognized facility. Overnight travel is required for the training program.

Responsibilities include all types of work involved with the installation, maintenance, operation, removal, and inspection of electrical distribution facilities including substations.

Candidates must be able to take direction. Candidates must be willing to accept accountability and responsibility for safe and efficient completion of work.

Qualifications:

- Must possess a high school degree or equivalent.
- Maintain a Class A CDL.
- Successfully pass a background check, drug/alcohol test and a physical and knowledge-based pre-hire assessment.
- Preference will be given to candidates that have completed a climbing program.

A strong commitment to safety is required.

The awarded candidate will be required to live within 20-minute response of the facility within the first 6 months of employment and is required to be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for scheduled or unscheduled assignments.
